

Ali's story – damaged tongue grows back (interviewed by Wendy Mann)

Ali: In August an ex-resident came back to the Hostel in a mess. He'd been in a hit and run incident and had 50 stitches in his face and couldn't really talk.

Wendy: So tell us what the staff at Barton House did.

Ali: The staff asked if they could pray for him and eventually when he'd thought about this he agreed, and 3 of them began to pray for him. As they did so, one of the support workers felt God prompt her to pray for his tongue to grow back – but that's impossible, as surgeons and doctors would say – the tongue can't grow back.

Wendy: But they prayed anyway. Now I know that he came back to the Hostel last week?

Ali: Yes, after he'd been prayed for the staff didn't see him for ages and then this week he came back. When he was asked, 'How are you doing?' he stuck out his tongue and all but a tiny chunk on the left side has grown back. The great thing is, when he was asked if it was ok to tell his story here at church he said, 'Well, yeah – it's a miracle'.
