1) VISION: WHAT'S THE POINT?

We believe that the greatest acts of the church are yet to take place and it's time for the church to rise up and fulfill its God given destiny. God is on the move and He's catching His church up in the mission that it was always called to fulfill - to make disciples of the nations. But are we ready? Are we equipped? We have this incredible message but have we learned how to declare it and demonstrate it in the same way that Jesus and his disciples did?

Training for Supernatural Ministry seeks to bridge that gap. Its aim is to train its students to effectively minister in the power of God and to equip and release believers to bring the Kingdom of God wherever they go. It's nine months of growing in our understanding of God's love for us and who we are in Christ which will outwork in a radical lifestyle, faith stretching encounters, courage building adventures and a lot of fun!



2) STORY: WHAT'S BEEN GOING ON?

The last few years have seen some incredible adventures in Bedford. We're on a journey but have seen God break out in amazing ways. We set a goal in 2008 of seeing 30 miracles of healing on the streets across 5 years but God has exceeded our wildest dreams and to date we've actually seen over 250 unbelievers who have been healed outside of church meetings. That's not even counting those who have been healed and set free on Sundays and as part of small groups. TSM is another part of our adventure with God. 3) ABOUT: WHAT DOES THE TRAINING INVOLVE?

TSM will start in September 2012 and is made up of the following components, offering a mix of settings for training, personal development and equipping:

- Teaching & equipping sessions & Tutorials
- King’s Arms conferences (Touching the Father’s Heart & Heaven Touches Earth)
- Hitting the streets (Treasure hunting & other outreach activities)
- Mission Trips
- Practical serving and ministry assignments within the local church
- Small Group Discipleship
- Private study and reading

4) SYLLABUS: WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

You will receive training based at the King's Arms Church, Bedford for one and a half days per week (Thursday day and Friday morning.) We will use some material from the Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry, Redding California and will cover topics under the following headings:

- 1) **Discovering your Identity in God:** (e.g. Touching the Father's Heart/Son or Servant/Knowing the God of Love)
- 2) **Kingdom Culture:** (e.g. What is the Kingdom/Revival History/ Salvation, Healing and Deliverance)
- 3) **Biblical Foundations:** (e.g. Old Testament History/New Testament Principles/ Detailed study of Specific Books)
- 4) **Prophetic Lifestyle:** (e.g. Hearing God's Voice/Receiving Words of Knowledge/ Growing in the Prophetic/Understanding Dreams)
- 5) **Personal Development and Gifting:** (e.g. Developing Spiritual Gifts/Culture of Courage and Risk/Growing in Authenticity)
- 6) **Equipped for Mission:** (e.g. Praying for the Sick/Deliverance/ Leading someone to Christ)

Training will be delivered by the course tutors & other invited speakers. Examples of visiting speakers from 2011/2012 include, Julian Adams, Neil and Sonya Chitty, Stef Liston and Phil & Carole Wilthew.

TSM can also be linked to the FP Impact course. Students doing TSM and FP Impact together will receive input with the other FP Students in 6 training blocks throughout the year. This material is taught by some of the best teachers and experienced church leaders in Newfrontiers and includes topics such as Church History, Doctrine of God, Doctrine of Salvation and Church Planting. 5) TRANSFORM: WHAT WILL TSM DO FOR YOU?

You can expect radical life change as you immerse yourself in TSM. You will encounter God in ways you've never known Him before; you will take hold of God's promises in His word and see the power that is released when you truly believe them; you will receive healing and freedom from the stuff that holds you back from being who you're called to be and doing what you're called to do. Training for Supernatural Ministry really will transform your life if you'll let it!

Students will receive in-depth teaching and 'hands-on' ministry in local churches and conferences in the UK. You will be actively involved in serving the church and seeing God's Kingdom come on the streets. You will grow in confidence in terms of your identity as a child of God as you experience the Father's heart; allowing you to minister out of who you are rather than what you do. You will discover new gifts and develop current ones. You will be spurred on to be all that you can be in Christ and you'll receive the freedom you need to wholeheartedly go after that. You will fall more and more in love with Jesus as you grow in intimacy with Him.

7) STRUCTURE: HOW DOES IT WORK?

There are three options for accessing TSM:

Option 1: TSM and FP Impact based in any church within commutable distance:

If you live within commutable distance of Bedford, you can attend the training for one and a half days a week and then return to your home church to put what you've learnt into practise.

Option 2: TSM and FP Impact based at King's Arms:

You can choose to be based at the King's Arms for your year. In addition to TSM, you will be involved in serving in a variety of areas of church life (e.g. Youth Work, Children's Ministry, Students, Healing Prayer etc)



Doing TSM and FP this year has been very challenging but so rewarding! I am having the most amazing year and feel so blessed to be part of what God is doing at King's Arms.



FP is such a wonderful way to get involved in and serve the church, from day one it was like I was surrounded by family. My project in youth work has been great fun. It is great seeing the youth fall more in love with Jesus.

On top of that there are the FP training blocks. Amazing worship times, teaching, friendships... I am really enjoying understanding more about God and the Bible and experiencing Him and putting the teaching into practice. TSM has been incredible. It has completely changed my life. Option 3: TSM as a stand alone course:

While students are encouraged to complete TSM alongside FP Impact it is possible to apply to access TSM as a stand alone course. Applicants will be assessed for their suitability on a person by person basis. Obviously if students have already completed the FP Impact/Frontier Year Project course they don't have to do it again but can apply to do TSM on its own.

8) MONEY: WHAT DOES IT COST

Options 1 and 2: The cost of TSM and FP Impact combined is £1900 (this includes £1150 for FP Impact fees)

Option 3: The cost of TSM as a stand-alone course is £1050

Fees are payable on admission. It is advised that you look to work part-time during your year with us. This will not only help with your finances; it will also provide you with opportunities to practise bringing the Kingdom of God in your workplace!

Mission Trips are an optional part of the TSM course and will be at an additional cost

9) INTERESTED: HOW TO APPLY?

Options 1 and 2: 2012/13 FP Impact training begins September 6th 2012 – TSM will start two weeks later. If you're interested in applying for FP Impact and TSM together, please request an application form by e-mailing fp@kingsarms.org or you can download a form at www.kingsarms.org/tsm. 10) INFORMATION: FOR CHURCH LEADERS

You might be wondering; why should I send people to this? Here's our thinking: our aim and motivation is not to bring students to Bedford never to return! It is to equip a whole generation to bring the Kingdom of God wherever they go. God has done some incredible things with us over the last few years and we want to give it away! As part of the course we will be encouraging students to work out what they are learning back at their home church. For those that come and base themselves at the King's Arms for the year, we'll be doing the same for when the year is over.

By investing in the students in this way we believe they will take what they have learned and begin to live it as a lifestyle - impacting those around them to do the same!

1 1) QUESTIONS: AND ANSWERS

1) Can I work part-time alongside TSM?

Answer: Yes; In fact, this is encouraged as it will provide you with opportunities to practise bringing the Kingdom of God in the workplace!

2) How will I find accommodation if I'm based at the King's Arms for the year and I'm coming from out of town?

Answer: We will do our best to assist you in finding accommodation for your year with us.

3) What if I decide to stay based at my home church but the commute is too far to return home on the Thursday evening before TSM on the Friday? Can I get overnight accommodation?

Answer: Again, we will try to put you in touch with people who will be able to provide you with accommodation for Thursday nights.

4) Who is TSM for?

Answer: TSM is for people from all stages of life (min age 18). Anyone who is up for taking some risks and experiencing significant life change! Our oldest student so far has been 70 and our youngest 18.

5) Will I receive any discipleship during the year?

Answer: You will receive small group discipleship throughout your year. We aim to foster a culture of openness and honesty at the King's Arms and we ask that you would be willing to embrace that.

We also ask that you have someone from your home church you can meet with 1:1 to process the things that God brings up throughout the year.
