

## **THE TREASURE PRINCIPLE - "LIVING WITH AN ETERNAL PERSPECTIVE" PHIL WILTHEW**

Matthew 6:19-21

1) A people living now for that which is eternal

This passage encourages us to store up for ourselves treasure in heaven - What do you think this means? How are you intentionally doing this right now?

Steve talked about living to hear God say to him, 'well done good and faithful servant.' Is your focus more on pleasing God or pleasing people/yourself?

What legacy do you want to leave on the earth?

Steve contrasted 'Giving to get', and 'Having to give' with the right motivation of us 'Getting to give' – do you live with this motivation?

2) Generosity and obedience are not just for the wealthy

Everything we have belongs to The Lord - is that your perspective? How are you using your possessions/time/money to be generous to those around you?

Share some stories of how you have been blessed by other people's generosity with their possessions/time/money.

Steve talked about his journey into tithing during a time of financial debt and how he saw God break in and bring provision. How have you experienced God blessing you as you have been obedient in giving?

Steve shared about the significance of being free from shame and walking in the light in the midst of his own finances – is there any thing that you'd like to share about your finances?

2) If you were discipling someone how would you explain to them what Jesus teaches about giving? How would you give them faith and vision to pursue radical generosity?
