Healed on the Train

Tabo: I was on my way home on the train after a long day at work and to be honest I just wanted to go to sleep! I sat next to a lady who kept wanting to talk to me, but it was nice because she was easy to talk to and it was good to be sitting next to someone friendly. After a while she got up to get a cup of tea and offered to get me one. When she came back, she put her tea on the table and got out some pills. She explained that this was prescribed medication as she had severe pain in her neck. This was stopping her from sleeping more than 4 hours a night and she was also getting extreme headaches and shoulder pain. She said she was seeing a physio, but the treatment wasn't working.

Then I asked how she felt and said, could she take her hands off her neck? As she did so utter shock and surprise came across her face as she realised the pain had gone.

Wendy: Did she say anything else? You said she looked very shocked that she'd been healed.
