The first church in the Bible - radical generous community.

1. RG Letournoir said "I shovel the money out but God shovels it back. And God has a bigger shovel."

2. Phil said that the early church was radically generous. How radically generous do you think we are as a church family? (give us a mark 1-10) What do we need to do in order to increase?

3. Ps 37:21 says that the righteous give generously. Why do you think that is?

4. Augustine said "God is always trying to give good things to us but our hands are too full to receive"

What do you think this means? What might your hands get 'full' with?

5. Phil spoke about using money to honour others. Read 2 Cor 9:11. Who does God want you to honour with finances?

6. Which nations of the world would you like to bless? Pray for those nations together.

7. What has God been saying to you thus far through the Treasure Principle series?

8. Phil said that sometimes we take a step of faith to give generously and then shortly afterwards an unforeseen expense comes up (car breaks down or washing machine floods). How do you think you can handle this?
