Radical generosity & food!

Acts 2:42-45 ...they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts,

Room-shaking prayer

Acts 4:23 When they were released, they went to their friends and reported what the chief priests and the elders had said to them. And when they heard it, they lifted their voices together to God...and when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit

Sharing their faith together

Acts 5:25 And someone came and told them, “Look! The men whom you put in prison are standing in the temple and teaching the people.”

Lives dramatically changed

Acts 9:17 So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.”

People raised from the dead

Acts 9:39-41 But Peter put them all outside, and knelt down and prayed; and turning to the body he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter she sat up. And he gave her his hand and raised her up. Then calling the saints and widows, he presented her alive.

Gentiles first filled with the Holy Spirit

Acts 10:24, 44 “And on the following day they entered Caesarea. Cornelius was expecting them and had called together his relatives and close friends. . . . While Peter was still saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell on all who heard the word.”

Life-changing Teaching

Acts 18:26 <Apollos> began to speak boldly in the synagogue, but when Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately.

Gifts of the Spirit exercised

Acts 21:11-13 And coming to us, <Agabus the prophet> took Paul 's belt and bound his own feet and hands and said, “Thus says the Holy Spirit, ‘This is how the Jews at Jerusalem will bind the man who owns this belt and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.’”
