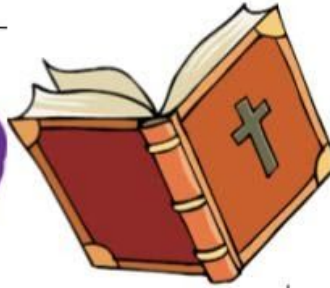


## Bible Story

### Talking/Connection Point:

This is where you can take time to chat to your children about what you have read/watched.

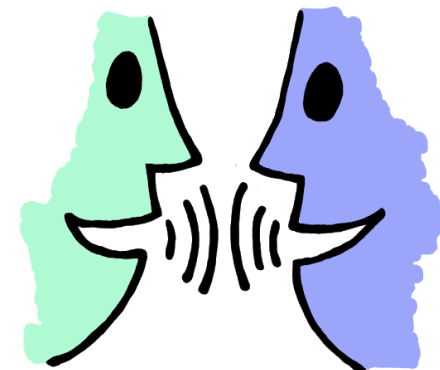
We've outlined some areas you can talk about and questions you can ask. But this is just a springboard for you, let the conversation flow and take time to listen to what your kids have to say. This is a precious time to build connection with each other and God

### School Age

- Take it in turns to say **'What things do you really love and would find hard to give up'** - eg: Chocolate, Coffee, Video Games, Mobile Phone- we'll come back to this later
- In the story Hannah gave up her son Samuel to serve God in the temple. Today we want to reflect on the sacrifice that our mum's make for us. Can you think of 3 things that your mum does for you that help you every day. Eg making your pack lunch, school.
- There are some things that your mum would sacrifice to be able to do all of these things for you. Why don't you take a minute to thank your mum for the things that she does to help you.
- In the same way as Hannah gave up Samuel, God gave up Jesus as a sacrifice so that we could be close to him. Earlier we talked about some of the things we would find hard to give up, **Do you think there is anything in that list that takes time away from you and God?**
- **Take a minute to write down some of these things. Is there one thing that you could change to help you spend more time with God?**

### Preschool

- Do you guys remember being younger and saying to your mum, "I love you THIS BIG!" (Spread your arms out as wide as you can.)
- Many will remember doing this. And did your mum ever say back, "Well, I love you THIS big?" (Spread your arms out even wider if possible or the widest you can.) Whose arms could spread out wider? Your arms or your mum's arms? Mum's arms could spread out wider. And why is that? Because her arms are longer.
- **What are some ways we know our mums love us?**
- Think about it. There is one person who loves more than a mum... GOD loves us more! Can you even believe that? **How can we know how much God loves us, when we can't even see him?**
- One way is that God loves us through mums. When your mum does something loving and kind for you, that's God doing it too! God is especially glad to have made mums because, while we're here on earth, it has given Him a way to show His love for you.



## Weekly Challenge

Think of 3 things that you could do this week to show your mum how much you love her and want to help her. This is for kids and grown ups! Eg:

- Clearing up your toys without being asked .
- Listening to your mum on the first time she says something.
- Writing her a little note each day to say something that you love about her.



## Activity

Draw a picture of how your mum shows you she loves you!

You will need:

- Card or paper
- Crayons/pens/colouring pencils



## Prayer

Try to encourage everyone to pray out loud (even if it is a short one)

Take some time to thank God for the sacrifice he made in giving us Jesus.

Thank God for our mums and for all they do for us.
