1. PURPOSE

Working alongside the Impact Team leader to provide additional leadership, administrative support and evangelistic passion to the King's Arms Team. Primarily serving as an evangelist at the King's House location in line with the Christian ethos of the King's Arms Trust.

2. CONTEXT

King's Arms Trust is a growing church across two locations with over 1100 adults, youth and children and a staff of around 50, most of whom are based at King's House. In addition, a large number of people are volunteering to work in support of the church. We're eager for this role to be a central element behind our desire to see more people encounter God's love and become disciples of Christ. The successful applicant will be expected to be an active member of the King's Arms based at the King's House location.

Occupational Requirement: This role carries an Occupational Requirement for the applicant to be an active committed Christian and to subscribe to the Objects and Statement of Beliefs of the King's Arms Trust (Bedford).

3. PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Outreach (Alpha) & Discipleship (Beta) or other course oversight

- Lead all aspects of the King's Arms Alpha and Beta courses.
- Recruitment, training, pastoral care and support of the volunteer team.
- Administration and promotion of the courses.
- Working hard to maximise all aspects of the smooth running of these courses enabling people to explore the claims of Christ and have the opportunity to encounter and respond to Him.

Evangelist to King's House

- Play an active role in the Impact Team - taking minutes in team meetings, contributing to ideas and development, and outworking practically the vision of the team.

- Provide evangelistic input to King's House meetings and key evangelistic Sundays such as Baptisms, Mother's Day, Easter Sunday and special Christmas events in line with the Christian ethos of the King's Arms Trust.
- Oversee the support and preparation of those getting baptised at King's House.

Other responsibilities and involvement

- Help to gather, equip and inspire evangelists across the church including the delivery of the annual Proclaim conference and termly Proclaim Local gatherings for King's Arms.
- Seek to pioneer and implement evangelistic initiatives to help the church to engage with those far from God and make disciples who make disciples.
- Active involvement and contribution to prayer meetings and other team meetings in line with the Christian ethos of the King's Arms Trust.
- Any other reasonable requests made by the Impact Team Leader.

- Is positive, dependable in a crisis, takes responsibility and offers solutions
- Has excellent interpersonal and leadership skills
- Is passionate about serving the wider King's Arms team and Christian vision
- Is a self-starter and capable of managing their own workload
- Works well under pressure and able to prioritise in a busy environment.
- Is comfortable working to deadlines
- Is self-motivated and reliable with personal integrity
- Resolves conflict in a healthy manner, valuing relationship
- Takes pride in their work and has an eye for detail
