What happens to my ticket if the conference is cancelled?

If for any reason we need to cancel the conference, you will receive a full refund.

Are tickets refundable?

For tickets cancelled before the 1st April we will provide a refund minus an administrative fee of £10. However, for any tickets cancelled after this point we will unfortunately not be able to provide a refund.

Are there any discounts available?

We have early bird discounted tickets available if you book before 1st April. We do also have a King's Arms member discounted ticket available, which is specifically for those who are part of King's Arms church. We consider members to be those who are serving and giving.
